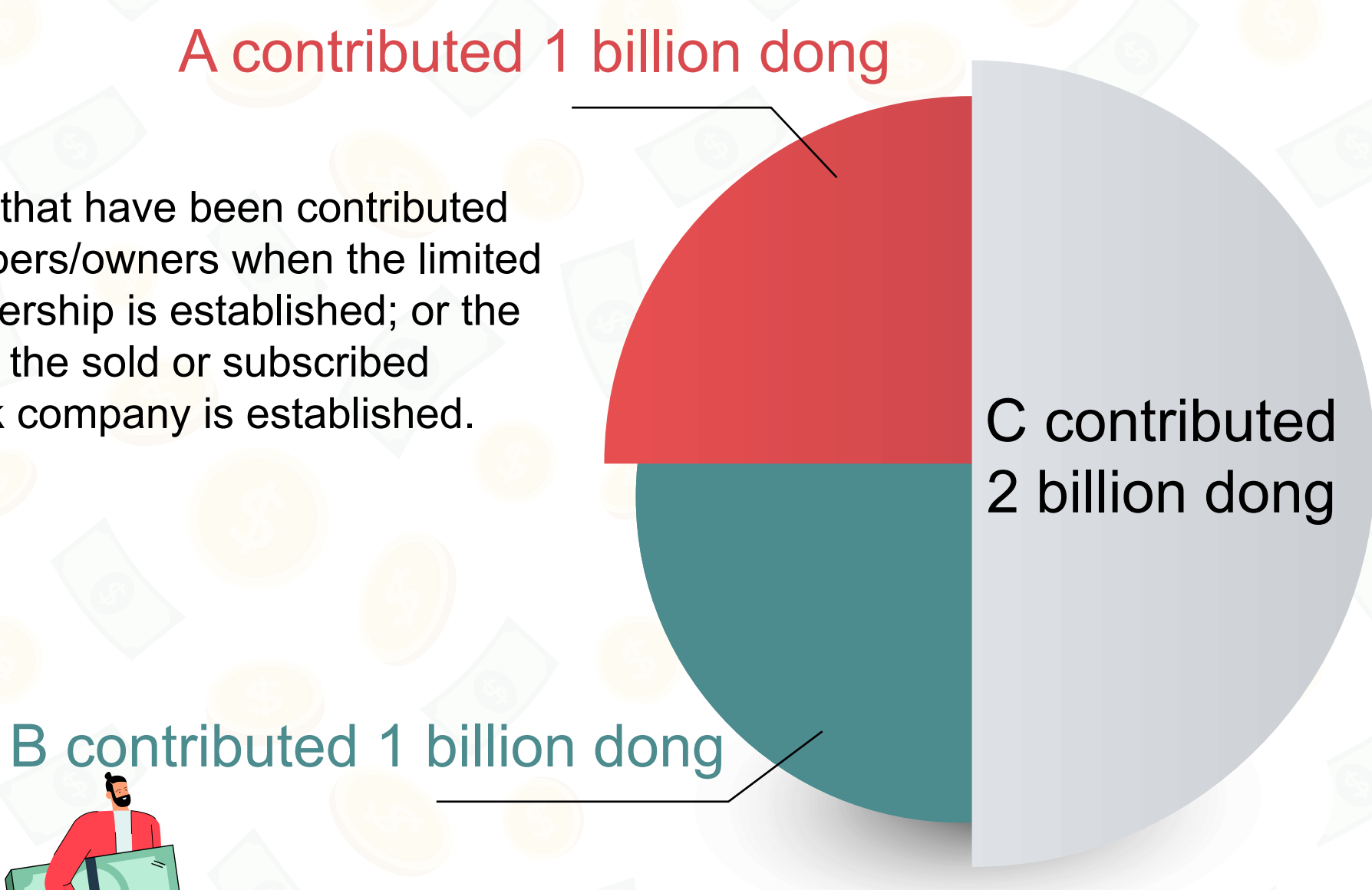

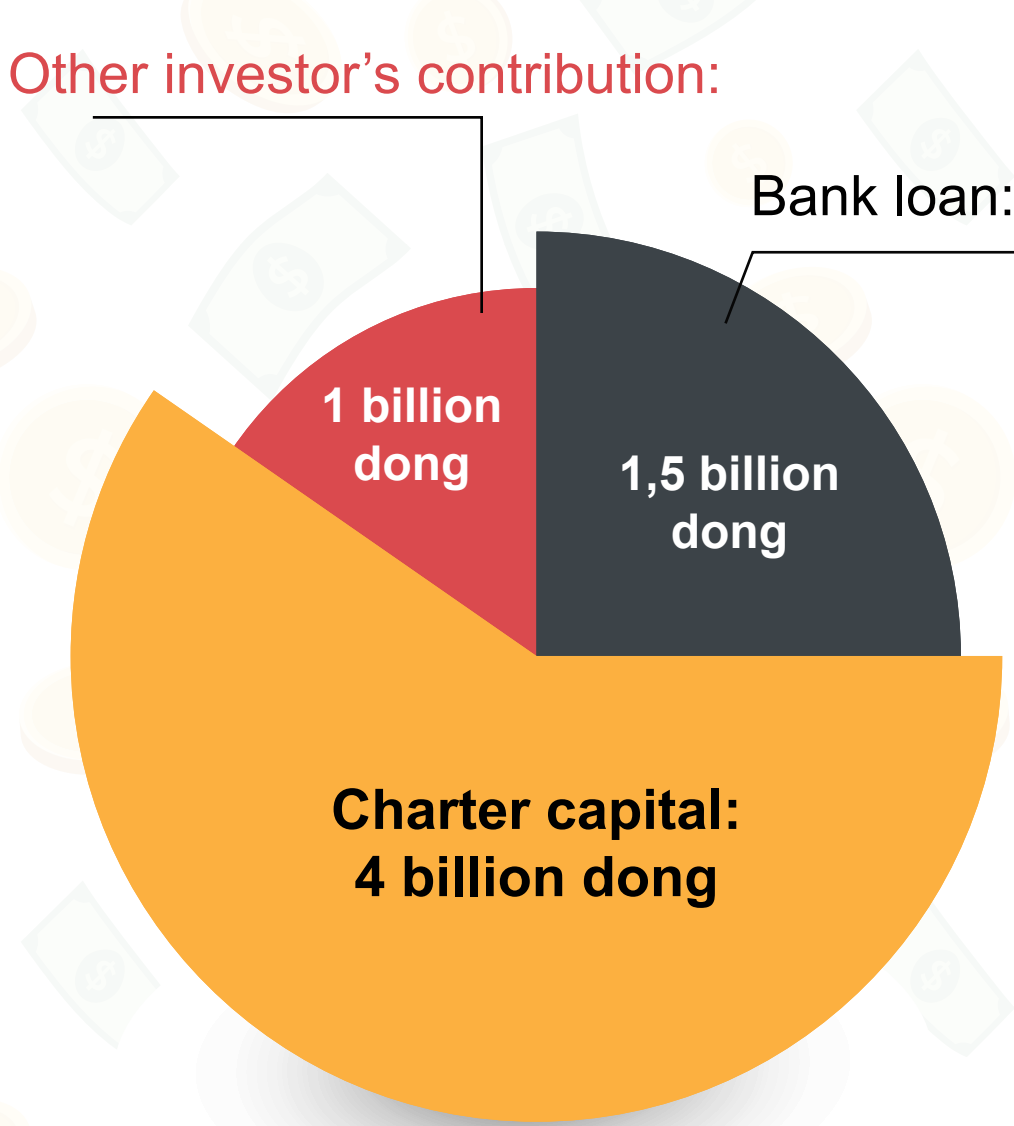
CHARTER CAPITAL

The total value of assets that have been contributed or promised by the members/owners when the limited liability company or partnership is established; or the total of nominal values of the sold or subscribed shares when a joint stock company is established.



The charter capital of Company X is 4 billion dong

INVESTMENT CAPITAL



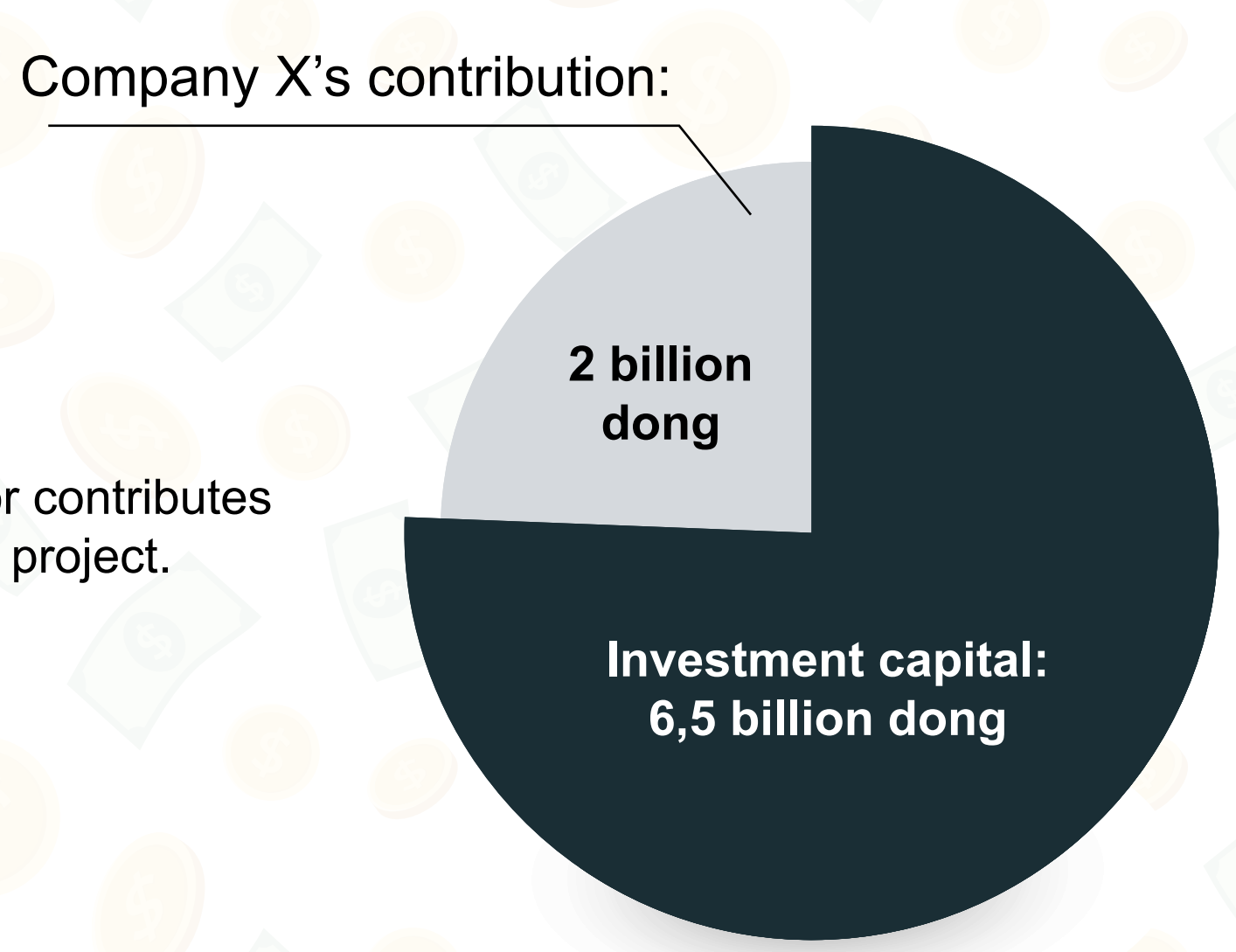
Total of all capital sources contributed to an investment project.

Investment capital: 6,5 billion dong



CAPITAL CONTRIBUTED TO PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

The amount of capital that an investor contributes to implementing a certain investment project.
