

SUBJECTS NOT ENTITLED TO INHERITANCE

(Pursuant to Article 621 of Civil Code 2015)

Be convicted of one of the following acts against the deceased:



Having intentionally caused the death of or harmed his/her health.



Having seriously mistreated or tortured him/her.



Having seriously harmed his/her honour or dignity.



Having seriously breached their duty to take care of the deceased.



Having intentionally caused the death of another heir to obtain the entitlement of such other heir to the estate.



Deceiving, coercing the deceased into making the will.



Obstructing the deceased with respect to the making of the will.



Forging, altering, destroying or concealing the will to obtain the estate contrary to the wishes of the deceased.

Individuals may, nevertheless, inherit the estate if the deceased was aware of such acts but still allowed them to inherit the estate under the will.
